Differentiation by Design

This professional learning course for educators is based upon the Jarvis Tomlinson model of Differentiation (Tomlinson and Jarvis 2009). The model focuses upon catering for the needs of all students, including the highly able. Differentiated and personalised teaching strategies that deliver rigorous and respectful learning experiences for students will be demonstrated and applied. Participating in the program will increase your capacity to cater for the needs of highly able learners. Should you wish to progress to post-graduate studies in Gifted Education at Flinders University, credit may be given to those participants who complete the whole course and submit written critical reflections. Participants will be equipped with workshop materials, Power Points and other learning aids. It is designed to meet the needs of educators, F –10.

Due to the impact of Covid-19, we have had to adjust the schedule and mode of delivery for the workshops. There are six workshops remaining in the course. Our Term 3 workshops will be completed using online delivery, from 5pm to 7pm. We will update participants about the Term 4 workshops closer to the time. These workshops can be taken as individual learning opportunities, so please feel free to join us even if you have not participated in the two workshops held in Semester 1.

In the remaining workshops, participants will

1. In Workshop 5, discover the power of cognitive verbs and progressions in differentiating learning, **(Tuesday August 18 – online learning)**
2. In Workshop 2 (rescheduled), learn how to determine and apply students' interests and learning preferences, **(26th August - online learning)**
3. In Workshop 6, discover how assessment can be differentiated, **(Thursday September 3 – online learning)**
4. In workshop 7, learn how students can develop a variety of products that demonstrate their knowledge and understanding, **(Thursday 5 November – mode to be announced)**
5. In Workshop 3 (rescheduled), learn how to assess the readiness of students to learn, **(Wednesday November 11 – mode to be announced)**
6. In Workshop 8, learn how resources and the learning environment can be adjusted to meet the needs of different learners. **(Tuesday November 17 – mode to be announced)**

Janet Farrall, a distinguished and highly experienced educator whose four decades of practice have ranged from the classroom to leadership, project management and consultancy, will present the workshops. She specialises in the education of highly able learners, dispositions for learning and differentiation by design. All workshops will employ a variety of thinking, learning and questioning tools designed to promote understanding and transfer of important concepts, theories and ideas.
